

DEK INTERNATIONAL SOFTWARE AND DOCUMENTATION LICENCE

This is a legal agreement between you (“you”) and DEK INTERNATIONAL GMBH (“us”, “we” or “DEK”).

USE OF THE SOFTWARE IS SUBJECT TO DEK’S LICENSE TERMS. THESE INCLUDE IMPORTANT LIMITATIONS AND EXCLUSIONS OF DEK LIABILITY WHICH YOU SHOULD CAREFULLY REVIEW.

1. Licence

We hereby grant you a non-exclusive, non-transferable licence to use the software product, and/or software product documentation or other documentation (including operating manuals) (the “Software”) you have ordered or otherwise requested with DEK equipment. This licence shall be perpetual unless the order details say otherwise. You may only use the Software on the equipment you specify on our online Software order form (subject to permitted transfer). You may make one back-up copy of the Software, provided that such copy shall be subject to the terms of this licence.

This licence does not entitle you to further software products or product support. These are available subject to agreement with us.

We reserve (and you accept) DEK’s right to use software keys, time out devices and other security measures to ensure compliance with these licence terms.

2. License and Software Transfer

You may not transfer the Software to a third party without our prior written consent. You are permitted to transfer the Software to other DEK equipment owned by yourselves provided that you give us advance notice of this and details of the equipment that the Software will be installed on.

3. Copyright and other intellectual property rights

All intellectual property rights in the Software are owned by us or our licensors and the Software is protected by international copyright and other applicable laws. You must not remove any copyright notices or other legends from the Software. If you are permitted to make copies, you must reproduce such notices and legends on the copy.

4. Further restrictions

You may not loan, rent, lease or licence the Software or any copy. You must not reverse engineer or decompile the Software. If you need interface information relating to the Software in order to interface with one of your software programs, please contact us.

5. Warranty

We warrant that for a period of 90 days after the Software has been made available to you (“Warranty Period”), the Software will in all material respects conform to the descriptions contained in our user documentation. In the event of a breach of this warranty, we agree to use reasonable endeavours to correct the fault and provide corrected Software to you provided that we can replicate the fault. If we are unable to correct the fault within a reasonable time, your sole remedy for breach of this warranty is to return the Software to us during the Warranty Period, together with dated proof of purchase, and we will, at our option, either replace the Software with an earlier version or provide a full refund of the price paid for the Software.

6. No other warranties

EXCEPT AS EXPRESSLY PROVIDED OTHERWISE BY THIS AGREEMENT, NO CONDITIONS, WARRANTIES, REPRESENTATIONS OR OTHER TERMS APPLY WITH RESPECT TO THE SOFTWARE (INCLUDING ANY SUCH TERMS AS TO QUALITY, PERFORMANCE, SUSTAINABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE)

7. Exclusions and limitations

We hereby exclude any liability under or in relation to this licence (whether due to negligence, breach of contract, misrepresentation or for any other reason) for any loss of profits, sales, turnover, loss of bargain, lost use of equipment, lost or damaged software or data, wasted management or other staff time or any indirect, special or consequential loss or damage. Subject to the preceding sentence, our total liability arising from or in connection with this licence and the Software provided (whether due to negligence, breach of contract, misrepresentation or for any other reason) shall be limited to the price paid for the Software delivered pursuant to this licence. However, we do not exclude any liability which may not, under applicable law be excluded or limited.

8. Termination

Your licence to use the Software automatically terminates if you fail to comply with any provision of this licence or if you have an administrator, receiver or administrative receiver appointed, if you pass a resolution for winding up (other than as part of a reconstruction) or if you enter into a voluntary arrangement with your creditors.

9. Export

You may not export, transfer or make available any Software to a third party in contravention of these licence terms, any applicable English law or to any entity in any country, which entity or country is for the time being, subject to a United States export embargo or other US export restrictions. You undertake that you will not use the

Software or any DEK equipment for any nuclear or chemical or biological weapons purposes.

10. General

This licence is governed by English law and both parties submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the English Court. It may not be assigned or transferred by you without our prior written consent. If any provision of this license is found to be unlawful or unenforceable then this shall not affect the remainder of the license.
